

# Durham VA Health Care System Fact Sheet

The Durham VA Health Care System is a comprehensive network that provides health services to Veterans through the Durham VA Medical Center, Greenville Health Care Center, Raleigh I, II, and III Community Based Outpatient Clinics, Morehead City CBOC, Hillandale I & II Clinics, and the Brier Creek Blind Rehabilitation Clinic and Brier Creek free standing Dialysis Clinic.

The health care system has a long history of conducting cutting edge research, establishing innovative medical programs, and providing compassionate care that meet the healthcare needs of Veterans. The medical center has 151 operating beds and a 100-bed, five-star rated Community Living Center.

DVAHCS has one of the top research programs in the Veterans Health Administration with \$38 million in research expenditures. The program consists of 480 research projects conducted by more than 150 investigators that push science further to benefit the healthcare of Veterans and the general population.


DVAHCS has five National Centers of Excellence in the areas of Primary Care, Mental Health, Epidemiology, Geriatrics, and Epilepsy. It has several other nationally recognized programs including: Cardiovascular and Diabetes care, and Tele-health.

## Accomplishments

- National leader in providing prompt, safe, innovative cardiovascular care for Veterans through the use of programs such as cardiac catheterization and stent placement using the radial artery in the wrist versus the traditional route of the femoral artery in the groin, same day access for cardiology consultation, and robotic angioplasty
- Leads the nation in Hepatitis C cure rates with the Durham VA Liver Clinic team successfully curing over 97 percent of Veterans who receive treatment within our healthcare system
- First VA in the nation to achieve accreditation for an Occupational Therapy Residency program
- Durham VA's Home-Based Mental Health Evaluation (HOME) was recognized as a VA best practice
- Reaffirmed position as a premier teaching hospital by becoming one of the first SimLEARN Certified Simulation Centers in the VA system, achieving and advanced level rating
